































Reading books are changed on a **Friday**. Please make sure that you return reading books in their book bags for changing.

The story that Christians find in the Bible about when Jesus was born	Who were the first visitors to Jesus? How did the shepherds know that Jesus had been born?	Recap with pupils' nativity story they read last time. Ask: Who is this story important for?	Ask pupils about the different Christmas celebrations they know of and to give examples. Explain that people celebrate Christmas in lots of different ways	Talk with pupils about the Christmas story. Ask: why is this story important for Christians?	Recap the story of the first Christmas. Choose a different version of the story and share it with pupils. Compare similarities and differences with the one read last time.	Consolidation
