Reminders

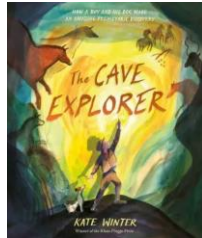
- **Swimming continues!**

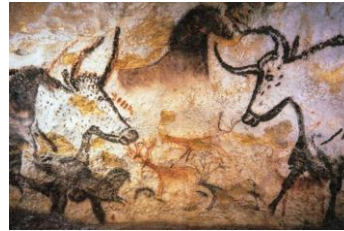
